PRINCE OF PEACE FOOD PANTRY

The 1st Sunday of each month is Food Pantry Sunday. We now have some people who will be helping this ministry which involves checking the food for expiration dates, organizing the food on shelves, and checking to see what items we can use in the pantry and notifying the congregation to the needs.

The FBI has work hard to stencil cloth bags for the congregation to use to bring the food to church. Our goal to decrease the use of plastic bags.

At the entrance of church, you will find a clothes pole with empty bags. Please take one bag home with you. Fill it with food to bring to church on Food Sunday. Place your full bag on the cart at the entrance and take a bag home for the next month. Every time you bring food to church take an empty bag home to fill for the next month. If we use the cloth bags we help our world in two ways...one by feeding the hungry and one by helping our environment.

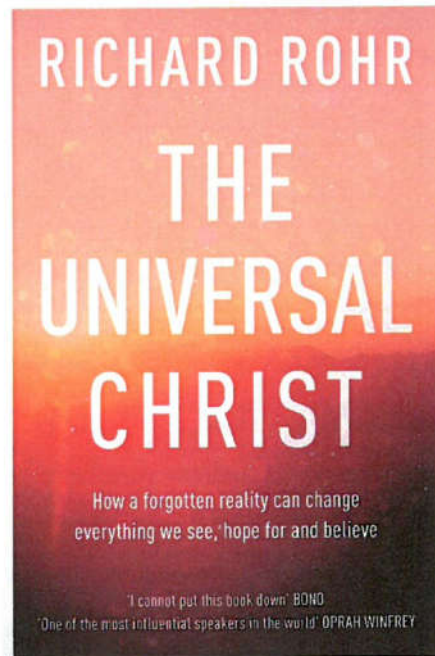
